Our House system will be the focal point for many of the activities and programs while we also partake in a number more grade-specific endeavours. 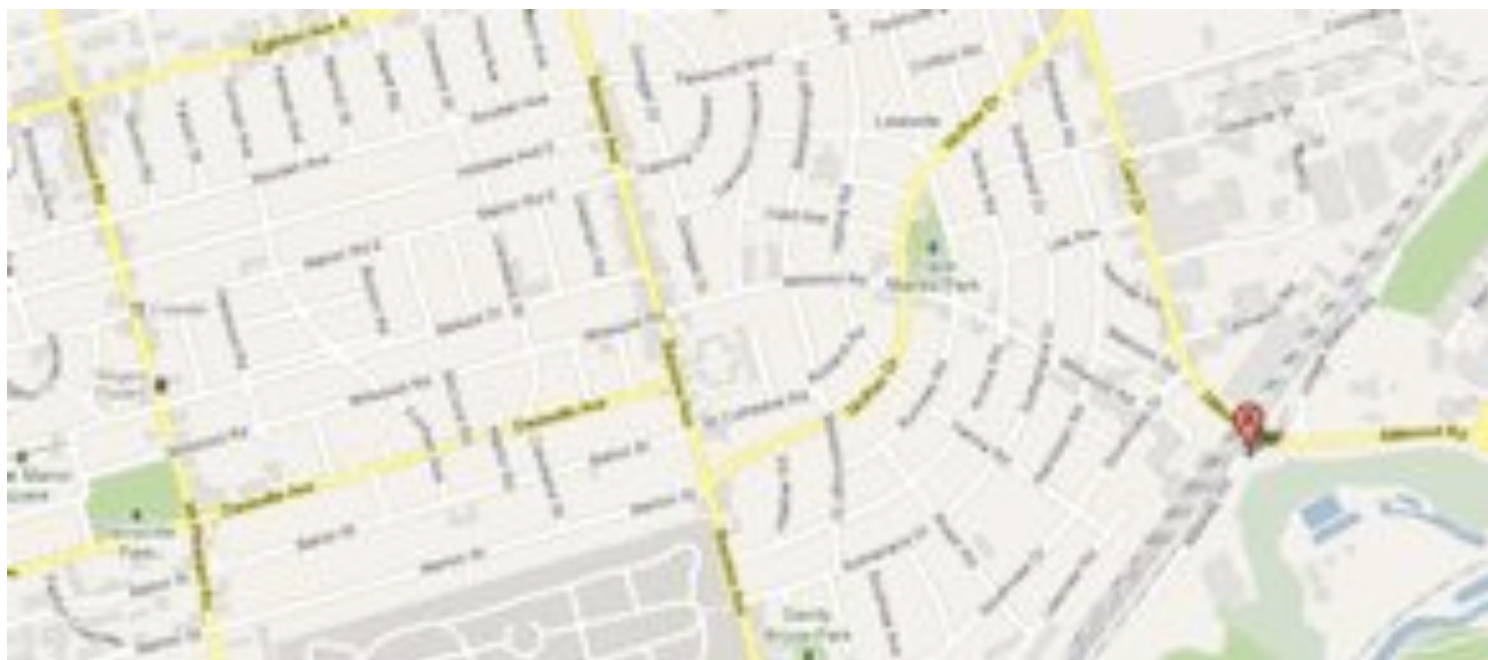
Buses will depart from the Loblaws parking lot at 10:00 A.M. sharp on Wednesday, September 11th , 2013.
